



Reducing 66 sites to 8

Of these 66 sites, 22 seemed to have green space potential and were subject to a more detailed assessment, including

- site visits and further fact finding
- critical examination against the National Planning Framework criteria.

From these, we have identified 8 where there is substantial evidence that they meet the Local Green Space Criteria.

Note. Where a site has not met the Local Green Space criteria it does **not** mean it can be used for development, nor does it ear-mark land for development. Furthermore, a site may already be subject to National or District policies, which exclude development for housing. A good example is the provision of recreation, sports and play where Lewes District Council already has a strong policy basis in place.
