

Evidence assessed against the following Sustainability Objectives:

- 1. Housing** - To deliver, in the first instance on brownfield sites, high quality new open market and affordable homes that meet the needs of the whole community both now and in the future.
- 2. Sustainable Transport (including walking/cycling)** - To ensure that the SNP area benefits from a robust, accessible and sustainable transport system for its residents, visitors and businesses, that: (i) encourages and facilitates sustainable economic development and access to services whilst (ii) reducing the need to travel by car.
- 3. Community infrastructure** – To maintain and enhance community infrastructure within the Parish.
- 4. Green Infrastructure** - To maintain and enhance green infrastructure within the Parish.
- 5. Heritage Assets** - To protect or enhance the heritage assets and historic environment of the Parish.

Sustainability Objectives Cont...:

6. Countryside, Landscape and Key Views - To conserve and enhance the countryside of the Parish and surrounding area, including the setting of the National Park.

7. Flood Risk - To steer new development away from areas at high risk of flooding or where it may cause or increase flooding either on site or elsewhere.

8. Biodiversity - To protect and enhance the biodiversity of the SNP area.

9. Sustainable Design – To encourage high quality design and layout in all new development and promote systems efficiency and local renewable energy production and to reduce the Parish’s impact on climate change.

10. Local businesses and tourism - Enhance and maintain the local economy in the SNP area by: (i) supporting employment and businesses and (ii) encourage tourism throughout.
